In addition to theater, Paul is a member of the Hometown Concert Band, the Villages Pops Chorus, the Accordion Club, and the Woodworkers Club. #### Gene Traupman – Ed Norton

Susan grew up in a household filled with music, dance and singing. Professionally, she was an executive for global product development and marketing for major telecom companies where her team developed and rolled out new technology products. She was a pioneer in Digital Quality Audio and Video working with MTV, Nickelodeon, Lucas Films and major Music Networks around the globe. She worked with collaborative global showcases where musicians from different continents and cities played together, including the New York Music Festival, Montreux Jazz Festival and Big Help. She supported major music and film studios as they started international production projects where the entertainers, directors and crew could be located anywhere and still work seamlessly together.

SMASH Productions was created in 2016 to give Villagers opportunities to participate in high quality stage shows. It just celebrated its fifteenth major production in March 2024 with *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* after our recent shows *Addams Family* and *Little Shop of Horrors*. Memorable shows include *Sound of Music*, three *Nunsense Shows, When You Wish Upon A Mouse* with music from Disney, *USO: 75 Years of Entertainment*, and *Rhapsody In Rhythm*. In April 2025, she will bring the hilarious Show Dolly Parton's 9 to 5 The Musical followed in the Fall of 2025 by the fantastic *Gypsy* and *Salute to Our Heroes*. *Cinderella* will enchant the Savannah Center Stage in the Spring 2026. Susan thanks her husband Stuart for his support and indulging her love of theater.

#### Barry Corlew - Director

Barry began his theater career in 4th grade and has never stopped! He directed his first show as a student director in 6th grade. While in the U.S. Navy, Barry worked with The Rota Little Theater (Spain). Professionally, Barry has worked with Café Lena Theater Project in Saratoga Springs, NY, and performed with Riverview Entertainment Productions (NY). He directed *Embraceable Me* off-off Broadway' in NYC and was the assistant director and had a featured role in the film, The Old Livingston House, shot locally in central Florida. He has also appeared in 10 other films and has over 150 theater credits as an actor and director.

A villager since 2009, Barry has worked with M&M Productions, VTC where he recently co- directed with Bob Petrucelli *Visit From Scarface*, VMT, Lake Miona and Melon Patch. For SMASH Productions he wrote and directed *Over the Rainbow -the Music of Harold Arlen*, *When You Wish Upon a Mouse...*the Music of Disney, *Rhapsody and Rhythm*. He directed *The Honeymooners from New York to The Villages*. He helped write and direct *The Cat's Meow Murder Mystery* for PW fundraiser at NLPC in Lady Lake and at Temple Shalom. #### Patty O'Toole Desai - Assistant Director, Stage Manager

#### Barbara Byers - Choreographer

Barbara has worked at the Walt Disney World in the Entertainment and Education Department for 12 years. She has been involved in dance and musical theater for most of her life starting at age 3 and owned her own dance school for 26 years. Since moving to the Villages in 2012, she has performed with Villages Musical Theater in *Brigadoon, The Music Man* and *Crazy for You*, and with Musicals in Concert, Music in Motion and the Pops Chorus. Current projects include simple online steaming videos to full feature HD videos with special effects, including Interfaith Community Programs, Holocaust Remembrance Observances and other special events. Jeff enjoys creating fish theme art using natural Florida materials.

#### Brian La Palma - Make Up Artist and Hair

Brian was allowed to graduate Windham High School in Willimantic CT one month early in order to start his career in show business. Brian had two concurrent careers.

Eight months of every year from 1976 to 2018, Brian was Ringmaster/Magician with circuses throughout the U.S. and Canada, and during the remaining four months of every year Brian worked as a theatrical makeup artist for stage shows like *The Wizard of OZ, Phantom of the Opera, Cats,* and hundreds of others. Now that Brian is retired from life on the road, he still performs as a Mentalist from time to time in The Villages, as well as doing makeup for Villages theatrical productions. Brian has worked with SMASH Productions for seven shows.

#### Dianne Bolton – Sounds and Projections



## **BIG FRANK TIES THE KNOT** Murder Mystery at The Cat's Meow Cafe
